Visitor Access To Wakehurst Place and the Millennium Seed Bank



Information for official visitors

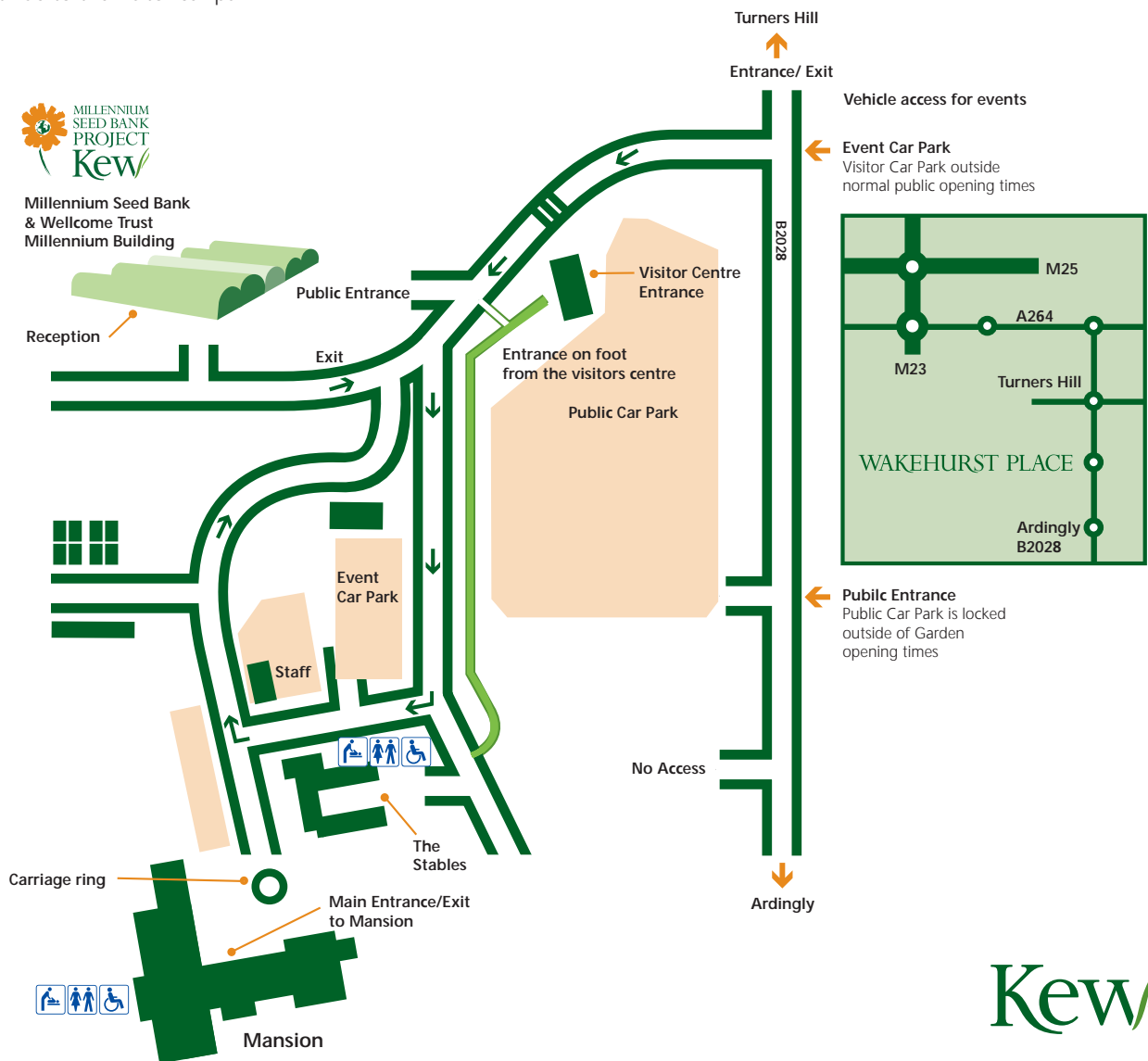
Wakehurst Place is situated on the Turners Hill Ardingly road (B2028) about 1 mile (1.6 km) north of Ardingly. When approaching from the M23, London/Gatwick, leave the motorway at Junction 10 signposted A264 East Grinstead. Follow the A264 to its junction with the B2028, where the direction to Wakehurst Place is clearly signposted. Please report to the Visitor Centre, in the main public car park, on arrival. Visitors in attendance outside public opening times should enter the estate via the North Drive, across the cattle grid round the one way system and continue to the visitor car park.

Please report to Reception (until 5pm) or to the Wellcome Trust Millennium Building Reception (after 5pm) arrival. Pedestrian access to the Mansion is gained by continuing through the iron gates and crossing the Carriage Ring to the Mansion main entrance.
